The B90 club at the Gdansk Shipyard hosted the AMBERIF Vibes gala, an integral part of the AMBERIF Spring 2025 trade fair. The modern fashion show with a musical finale gathered lovers of amber, fashion and art in industrial spaces, emphasizing the timeless nature of this precious stone. The runway was graced by, among others, Bogna Sworowska, Lidia Popiel, Robert Kupisz and Szymon Bieniuk.

The space of B90 club perfectly matched the raw grunge style, creating a unique atmosphere for the presented collections. The evening was hosted by **Aleksandra Szutenberg**, and the show was directed by **Maciej Majzner**.

The runway featured legends of Polish modeling, including **Bogna Sworowska** and **Lidia Popiel**, as well as **Robert Kupisz**, who is better known as a fashion designer and has recently been shining on the runways himself. Alongside models with extensive professional achievements, the catwalk was also graced by **Szymon Bieniuk**, a newcomer to the industry, and models from the Selective agency, including **Maja Słodzińska**.

The event was opened by a show of the jewellery collection by **Daria Burkowska**, who runs Dorbur company, which perfectly matched the clothing by **Monika Szymikowska**. 11 designers took part in the joint show of the AMBERIF exhibitors, each of whom presented 3 sets of jewellery presented on uniform outfits, thanks to which all attention was focused on the products of jewellery artists. The collective show featured works by:

The event concluded with 3 shows by exhibitors of the Fair selected by a special committee composed of members of the AMBERIF Program Council. **Dorota Cenecka**, in a duet with fashion designer **Natasha Pavluchenko**, presented jewelry with magnificent amber, which beautifully matched black dresses. An intriguing collection inspired by the Northern Lights was presented by **Joanna Kotowicz-Buczyńska** and **Michał Starost**. At the end, the participants could admire colorful outfits and jewelry by **Jola Słoma** and **Mirek Trymbulak**, who focused on Venetian accents.

During the event, the results of two "amber" competitions were announced. The AMBERIF Design Award, which aims to promote amber as an artistic material, gathered a record number of 250 participants from 34 countries this year, who submitted a total of 365 works. The Grand Prix – the prize of the Mayor of the City of Gdansk and a check worth PLN 30.000 was awarded to **Fumiko Gotô** from Switzerland for the brooch "Of Shadows". The silver price of the Gdansk International Fair Co. in the form of 1 kg of silver went to **Karol Zagórowski** from Poland, who won it for the ring "Good joke". The amber prize funded by the International Amber Association (1 kg of amber) was awarded to **Gabriela Kozłowska** for the ear jewellery "My deepest voice".

Special distinctions were also awarded by the YES Gallery – 250 grams of silver were awarded to the authors of two works: **Emilia Kohut** for the object "I LUV Y" and the duo **Julita Dąbrowska & Duchna Łosiak** for the earring "Vulcano".

The AMBERIF Selection competition distinguished the exhibitors of the Fair. As many as 3 designers received distinctions: **CHILLI Ireneusz Glaza** received a distinction for an amber ring, designer **Ryszard Węsierski** from A2 Jewellery received a distinction for the "Lagoon" ring, and designer **Weronika Majewska** from Weroarte Weronika Majewska was distinguished for the "Waterfalls" pendant.

The Gdansk International Fair Co. statuette was awarded to **Andrzej Boss** for the "Banksy" pendant. The Grand Prix – Award of the Ministry of Development and Technology was awarded to designer **Ryszard Węsierski** (A2 Jewellery) for the "DAYDREAM" ring. Additional prizes for the two winners of the main prizes were bags with amber from the BATYCKI company.

AMBERIF Vibes 2025 proved once again that amber is a timeless symbol of elegance that appeals to audiences of all ages. The combination of fashion, jewellery and music in the industrial setting of the B90 club created an unforgettable experience, emphasizing the uniqueness and versatility of amber in modern design.
